
Next month we will have our AGM on the 26th of August so there will be no general meeting, just our AGM followed by our presentation dinner. Hope to see your all there for a good night.

There were masses of Albacore tagged at Merimbula, plus a few Sharks and a Short Billed Spearfish. Snappy did his usual and captured a Blur and a Mako that weighed.

There was a lot of really bad language and abuse on the radio during the Merimbula Open which was very disappointing. Ron Del La Mare, President of Bermagui BGAC, gave them a serve and tried to make them understand that the licence for Chanel 22 could be revoked if this behaviour continues.
