Secretary's Report

Hello Members,

May has been a very busy month for the Club with the Annual Yellowfin Tournament taking place on the 20th, 21st and 22nd. First I would like to thank all of the sponsor who helped us to host our Tournament, without whose help it would simply have not been possible.

I would also like to thank everyone who attended the event both from our Club and the various Club's throughout the country. Finally a special thank you to everyone who helped out during the weekend which enabled a smooth tournament experience to take place. Unfortunately the fishing and the weather weren't in our favour during the tournament, with the first day being called off and a noticeable absence of the coveted Yellowfin Tuna. Of note were some sharks tagged and released on *Escape, Snappy tom and Elegantly Wasted*, as shortbilled spearfish on *Suzie M*, and a lone albacore amongst the reports.

We will be discussing the tournament at the next meeting to see how we can improve upon what we do well to ensure that the Club continues to remain in a position to present a premium tournament to competitors into the future.

I have received correspondence from NSW GFA in regards to the NSWGFA AGM as follows. Any notice of motion (addition and/or amendment to the NSWGFA Bylaws) must be received in writing prior to the 1st of July. Constitutional amendments received prior to June 10th, items for discussion prior to 1st of July, nominations for NSWGFA executive positions prior to the 1st of June, and accompanying acceptance of nomination. Please note these must be submitted to NSW by these dates and require signing off by our Club so we will need to receive these documents prior to the aforementioned dates if you wish to have them considered.

Changes to our Club, as the effective year within for Club reporting purposes begins on the 1st of June through to 31st of July memberships are now eligible to be renewed. Note: <u>This must be done before any capture or tag &</u> release can be recognised

Each entrant will be supplied with welcome letter by their State Coordinator after their entry has been received by the GFAA Coordinator.

Categories

Small Fry - Capture/Tag & Release/Measure & Release Anglers under the age of 11 years at the date entry is accepted. If you turn 11 years after entering the tournament you are eligible to fish in the "Small Fry" category until the end of the tournament year i.e. 30th June

Junior - Capture/Tag & Release/Measure & Release Anglers 11 years at the date entry is accepted and under 16 years are eligible to fish in this tournament. If you are 15 at the beginning of the tournament year you may fish and be eligible for trophies until your 16th birthday.
