

Batemans Bay GFC and Bermagui BGAC both had successful tournaments in January with a good number of fish and healthy boat numbers. Panlicker took out the Heaviest Marlin at Bermi with a Blue of 193.2kg.

I have just done the radio for both Ulladulla GFC and Shellharbour GFC. Both clubs had reasonable numbers for their events and a large number of Marlin tagged with Ulladulla tagging over 80 and Shellharbour over 40. There were also Sharks and Other Game Fish tagged. At Ulladulla the only fish weighed was a 12.5kg Mahi Mahi on Kempy, which took out the Shootout and Heaviest Other Game fish for the tournament.

Shellharbour weighed a 227.9kg Tiger Shark and a 6.6kg Mahi Mahi on Reckless, plus a 113.5kg Striped Marlin




on Black Dog. Other Marlin were weighed but did not make the cut off weight. Off to Eden GFC today and then the Interclub at Port Stephens, so a busy month for me.

It is good to see boats travelling to tournaments other than their own and I know this is appreciated by the host clubs. There are so many tournaments on the calendar and I am sure it is hard to choose which ones to attend, but it would be nice to think that clubs reciprocate attendance at their events. Costs are increasing and many clubs rely on their tournaments for their financial viability.

March brings us our Southern Zone Interclub 10-11. For a small entry fee anglers can fish out of their home ports and represent their respected clubs. Entry form for this will be sent to secretaries next week. The Alliance Tag & Release tournament is on the same weekend out of Bermagui. We also have Shoalhaven GFC's tournament 23-25 which is always a good one well worth entering.
